Dear Parent

Welcome back after the Easter break.

#### **School Lunch**

### School Uniform

Towards Easter a number of children were wearing bright fluorescent shoes to school, please note that the school uniform is 'sensible dark outdoor shoes'. If there is a temporary problem such as shoes needing to be replaced, parents should send the child with a letter to the classteacher to explain.
